

# Case Study

## Kier Group

**K**ier were appointed as partner to the City of Stoke-on-Trent on the joint venture for the maintenance of 22,000 domestic units under the decent homes scheme. Following a gateway process Environmental Essentials were granted approved status. Environmental Essentials have since been commissioned to carry out Type 2 Asbestos Surveys on domestic properties prior to refurbishment schemes. During this time we have developed IT systems including a web enabled database which allows Kier to access surveys and air monitoring records via the web.

### Type 2 Asbestos Survey

EEL have been involved with the development of data capture survey methodology and reporting methods for Kier Group. This bespoke design allows Kier to have an in depth analysis of all their asbestos issues.

EEL capture data through hand held PDA phones the information collected is directed to our own server and a report is generated. Our Technical Review team then quality checks the information prior to our report being released and plans are prepared by our CAD technicians. Kier Group once the data is transferred can access the data on line by property, floor, room number etc. This means that any contractor visiting site to do any refurbishment work is able through the asbestos team to access live information as to the whereabouts if any asbestos present.
